It has two (2) components programs: (1) DOLE Integrated Livelihood Program (DILP) otherwise known as the KABUHAYAN Program; and (2) Emergency Employment Program (EEP) otherwise known as the Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers (TUPAD) Program

Alien Employment Permit (AEP)	To regulate foreign national who intend to work in the Philippines and to legally engage in gainful employment in the country.	One of the requirements of the foreign nationals who intend to engage in gainful employment in the Philippines.
Workers Organization and Development Program (WODP) Scholarship	To provide educational assistance to Officers and members of workers organization including their legitimate dependent child.	The program is college/vocational scholarship granted to qualified officers and members of workers organization including their legitimate dependent child.
Workers Organization and Development Program (WODP) Training	To provide enhancement of the capabilities of workers organization towards promotion of trade unionism, workers empowerment, and sound labor management.	The program provide support for the development and upgrading of the capabilities of officer and members of labor organizations in the areas of leadership, organizational development and management, labor relations, human relations and productivity module, grievance handling, paralegal, labor standards and inspection, security of tenure, occupational safety and health and such other latest laws and issuances.

COVID-19 Adjustment Measures Program (CAMP)	Aims to provide financial support to affected workers in private establishments to mitigate the adverse economic impacts and reduction of income brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.	The program is a safety net program that offers financial support to affected workers in private establishments that have adopted Flexible Work Arrangement (FWA) or temporary closure during the COVID-19 pandemic.
Government Internship Program (GIP)	To engage beneficiaries into public service by involving them in government programs and projects, through the various GIP partner agencies.	The program provides the youth particularly the poor and indigent an opportunity to demonstrate their talents and skills in the field of public service with the ultimate objective of attracting the best and the brightest who want to pursue a career in government service, particularly in the fields and disciplines related to labor and employment. The internship period runs for a minimum of three (3) months to a maximum of six (6) months.

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
